— CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- Is the most accurate kicker in NFL history (90.2%), connecting on 395-of-438 FG attempts
- Is tied (with Sebastian Janikowski) for the second-most FGM (58) from 50-plus yards in NFL history (Matt Prater, 80)
- Since 2012, ranks No. 1 in FGs (395) and points (1,649)
- His 395 FGM, 1,649 points scored and 464 PATs made are the most in Ravens franchise history, surpassing K Matt Stover in each category in 2022
- His 94.2 career FG% in the second half/OT (195-of-207) ranks as the NFL's best such mark of all time
- Owns 19-career game-winning FGs (18 regular season and 1 playoff), connecting on 11 of those in road games
- Is 27-of-30 (90.0%) in the final two minutes of regulation, 18-of-20 (90.0%) on tries in the final minute of regulation and a perfect 5-of-5 on OT attempts throughout his career
- Owns the most points (84) and FGM (17) in Ravens postseason history
- His seven seasons with at least 140 points (2013, 2016-19, 2022-23) are tied (with K Stephen Gostkowski) for the most in NFL history

- Is the first kicker in NFL history to produce nine seasons with 30-plus FGM (2012-13, 2015-18, 2021-23)
- Is the first kicker in NFL history to register at least 130 points in eight straight seasons (2016-23)
- Is the only kicker in NFL history with two go-ahead 60-plus-yard FGM in the final minute of regulation (66 yards – 9/26/21 at Det.; 61 yards – 12/16/13 at Det.)
- En route to earning his seventh Pro Bowl honor in 2023, connected on 32-of-37 FGs (86.5%) and 51-of-52 PATs for a career-high and Ravens single-season record 147 points, a figure that also ranked No. 2 in the NFL...Reached 30-plus FGM in a season for the ninth time in his career, with no other kicker in the NFL history owning more than five such seasons...Notched his seventh-career 140-point campaign, tying (K Stephen Gostkowski) for the most in NFL history
- In 2022, connected on 37-of-43 FGs (86.0%) for a career-high and Ravens single-season record 142 points, a figure that also ranked No. 2 in the NFL, en route to his sixth-career Pro Bowl honor and a second-team All-Pro selection...His 37 FGM ranked No. 1 in the NFL...Surpassed K Matt Stover for the No. 1 spot in every major kicking category on Baltimore's all-time charts, including FGM, points scored and PATs...Recorded his seventh-straight season with at least 130 points and eighth overall with at least 30 FGM, each marking an NFL record...Helped Baltimore's special teams rank No. 3 in *Football Outsiders'* DVOA rating
- Connected on 65 consecutive fourth quarter/OT FGAs without a miss from 9/11/16-11/20/22 and 82 consecutive second half/OT FGAs without a miss from 11/19/17-11/27/22, with both figures marking the longest such streaks in NFL history...A potential game-winning, career-long 67-yard FGA at Jax. (11/27/22) snapped his record-long streaks
- Reached several career milestones in 2021: Registered at least 130 points for an NFL-record sixth-straight season; produced 30 FGM for an NFL-record seventh season overall; surpassed K Stephen Gostkowski (1,330) for the most points scored through a player's first 10 seasons in NFL history, finishing 1,360 in his 10th year
- In 2021, en route to earning his fifth career Pro Bowl honor (and third straight), connected on 35-of-37 FGs and all 32 PAT tries, producing the NFL's highest marks in FG% (95.6%) and PAT% (100%)...Finished a perfect 6-of-6 on 50-plus-yard FGAs and 18-of-18 on second half FGs, including 10-of-10 in the fourth quarter/OT...Connected on two game-winners – the 17th and 18th of his career – including the NFL-record 66-yarder at Det. (9/26/21)...Helped Baltimore's special teams unit rank No. 1 in *Football Outsiders'* DVOA rating
- Became the fastest kicker to 300 FGM, reaching that mark in his 148th-career game (at Den. 10/3/21)

- En route to AFC ST Player of the Week honors, connected on 4-of-5 FGAs, including a 50-yarder and the game-winning, NFL-record 66-yarder, in the 19-17 victory at Det. (9/26/21)...Made kicks from 39, 50, 32 and 66 yards, after missing a 49-yard try (WR)...Notched his 17th-career game-winning FG (including playoffs) and improved to 16-of-16 on tries in the final minute of regulation during his career
- Connected on a game-winning and NFL record-long 66-yard FG at Det. (9/26/21)
- In 2020, connected on 26-of-29 (89.7) FGAs and 52-of-53 (98.1) PATs, en route to his fourth-overall and second-consecutive Pro Bowl nod...Finished with at least 130 points for his fifth-consecutive season, tying the NFL record of consecutive seasons with 130-plus points (Stephen Gostkowski, 2011-15 & David Akers, 2008-12)
- In Week 6 of 2019, became the fastest kicker in NFL history (118 games) to score 1,000 career points (10/13/19 vs. Cin.)
- In 2019, connected on 28-of-29 FGAs (96.6%) and a franchise-record 57-of-59 PATs, marking his fourth-consecutive year scoring exactly 141 points...Helped the Ravens produce the NFL's No. 1 scoring offense (33.2 ppg) and set a team record for points (531)
- In 2018, became the fastest pure kicker in league history to reach the 900-point (107 games) and 800-point milestone (95 games)...Only Gino Cappelletti (a WR/kicker combo from 1960-70) did it faster (106 & 93 games, respectively)
- In 2016, earned his second Pro Bowl invitation and was a unanimous first-team All-Pro selection after producing perhaps the greatest season ever by an NFL kicker...Scored a single-season franchise-record 141 points, connecting on 38-of-39 FGs (lone miss was a block) and 27-of-27 PATs
- In 2016, Tucker's 38 FGs ranked first in the NFL, while he was 10-for-10 from 50-plus yards, tying (Blair Walsh, 2012 and Brandon McManus, 2020) for the most such kicks in NFL single-season history...An NFL single-season record 24 of Tucker's 38 FGs made came from 40 yards or beyond (he was 24-of-24 on such boots)
- Fastest kicker in NFL history to make 100 FGs (50 games) and to reach the 500-point milestone (60 games), overtaking Hall of Famer Jan Stenerud (61 games)
- Became just the ninth kicker in league history to make 3 FGs of 50-plus yards in a single game, connecting on kicks of 52, 57 & 54 yards, vs. Cin. (11/27/16)
- Kicked a game-winning FG as part of a franchise-record 6 (29, 24, 32, 49, 53 and 61) in the victory at Det. (12/16/13), becoming the only kicker in NFL history to kick FGs from the 20-, 30-, 40-, 50- and 60-yard ranges in a single game
- His 12-career AFC Special Teams Player of the Week awards are the most in franchise history...His seven AFC Special Teams Player of the Month selections are the most ever by a ST player and are three more than Ravens legends S Ed Reed & K Matt Stover for the most in franchise history

- He and wife, Amanda, have a son, Easton (9)
- Can sing opera in seven different languages: English, Spanish, French, German, Italian, Latin and Russian
- Appeared on the 2018 CBS show "Most Valuable Performer," winning the competition by singing "Ave Maria"
- Likes to do impressions of celebrities such as George W. Bush, Matthew McConaughey, Christopher Walken and former teammate Ray Lewis
- Pre-game ritual is to lay out his entire uniform (helmet to cleats) on the floor in front of his locker, just as childhood football hero Deion Sanders did

2023: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/0, 2/0)

- En route to earning his seventh Pro Bowl honor, connected on 32-of-37 FGs (86.5%) and 51-of-52 PATs for a career-high and Ravens single-season record 147 points, a figure that also ranked No. 2 in the NFL...Reached 30-plus FGM in a season for the ninth time in his career, with no other kicker in the NFL history owning more than five such seasons...Notched his seventh-career 140-point campaign, tying (K Stephen Gostkowski) for the most in NFL history
- Connected on FGs from 53 and 43 yards, while drilling all 4 PATs in the 34-10 Divisional Playoff win vs. Hou. (1/20/24)...Surpassed K Matt Stover for the most FGs made (17) in Ravens postseason history...The 53-yarder – his longest make of the season (regular + postseason) – for Baltimore's first points also marked the longest make in Ravens postseason history
- Connected on 8-of-8 PATs in the No.-1-seed-clinching 56-19 win vs. Mia. (12/31)...Set a new career high and franchise record for points scored in a season (143 and counting), while also notching his seventh-career 140-point campaign, which tie (K Stephen Gostkowski) for the most in NFL history
- Connected on 4 FGs (28, 41, 28 and 24 yards), while drilling all 3 PATs, for a game-high 15 points in the 33-19 win at SF (12/25)...Reached 30 FGM in a season for the ninth time in his career, with no other kicker in the NFL history owning more than five such seasons...Also surpassed K Stephen Gostkowski (390) for the 15th-most FGM (394) in NFL history
- Connected on 3 FGs (43, 34 and 26 yards) and 2 PATs, overcoming 10-plus MPH winds and rainy conditions in the playoff-clinching 23-7 win at Jax. (12/17)...Became the first kicker in NFL history to record at least 25 FGs in each of the first 12 seasons of a career, while also eclipsing K Stephen Gostkowski (1,613) for the most points scored (1,622) through the first 12 seasons of a career
- Connected on all 3 FGAs (31, 47 & 33 yards) and 2 PATs in the 37-31 OT win vs. LAR (12/10)
- Connected on FGs from 25 and 47 yards, while drilling all 4 PATs in the 34-20 win vs. Cin. (11/16)...Surpassed K Stephen Gostkowski for the most multi-FG games (117) through the first 12 years of a career in NFL history

- Connected on 6 FGs (20, 23, 28, 29, 36 & 41 yards) in the 24-16 victory at Ten. (10/16 in London), matching a franchise and personal single-game record...Became the fifth kicker (Gary Anderson, Tyler Bass, John Carney & Jeff Wilkins) in NFL history to twice connect on 6 FGs in a single game

2022: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/0, 1/0)

- Connected on 37-of-43 FGs (86.0%) for a career-high and Ravens single-season record 142 points, a figure that also ranked No. 2 in the NFL, en route to his sixth-career Pro Bowl honor and a second-team All-Pro selection...His 37 FGM ranked No. 1 in the NFL...Surpassed K Matt Stover for the No. 1 spot in every major kicking category on Baltimore's all-time charts, including FGM, points scored and PATs...Recorded his seventh-straight season with at least 130 points and eighth overall with at least 30 FGM, each marking an NFL record...Helped Baltimore's special teams rank No. 3 in *Football Outsiders'* DVOA rating
- Connected on a 22-yard FG to put Baltimore ahead, 10-9, just before halftime, in the Wild Card Playoff at Cin. (1/15/23)...With 5 points scored (1 FG & 2 PATs), surpassed K Matt Stover (70) for the most points scored (74) in Ravens postseason history
- With FGM from 26, 27 & 51 yards and 1 PAT at Cin. (1/8/23), set a new single-season high in points scored (142), surpassing his previous career-best 141-point seasons (2016-19)...Also achieved 1,500 career points, becoming the second-fastest player (178 games) in NFL history to reach that mark (Stephen Gostkowski – 173 games)
- Connected on FGs from 30 yards and 51 yards vs. Pit. (1/1/23)...Achieved his seventh-straight season and ninth overall (2012-13, 2016-22) with at least 130 points scored...His seven straight seasons reaching that mark are an NFL record, while his nine overall seasons with at least 130 points are tied with K Stephen Gostkowski for the most in NFL history
- Connected on 3 FGs within 30 yards (2 from 21 yards & a 27-yarder) in the 17-9 victory vs. Atl. (12/24)...Recorded his eighth season with at least 30 FGM, marking the most in NFL history
- Connected on a 53-yard FG at Cle. (12/17) to surpass K Matt Stover's record for the most FGM in Ravens franchise history
- Connected on FGs from 30, 35 and 42 yards in the 16-14 victory at Pit. (12/11)...Surpassed K Matt Stover for the most points scored in Ravens franchise history on his 42-yarder for the game's first points...Connected on his 24th-, 25th- and 26th-consecutive field goal in Pittsburgh, known as one of the harder places to kick
- Connected on FGs from 24, 27, 29 and 55 yards, while coming up just short on the potential game-winning 67-yarder – the longest attempt of his career – at Jax. (11/27)
- Drilled FGAs of 32 yards, 34 yards and 55 yards in the 23-20 win vs. Cle. (10/23)...Surpassed Jason Hanson for the third-most 50+ yard FGM (53) in NFL history and Stephen Gostkowski for the most multi-FG performances (105) though the first 11 seasons of an NFL career
- Converted all 4 of his FGAs – 37-yarder for the game's first points, a 58-yarder to put Baltimore ahead 13-10, a 25-yarder to extend Baltimore's lead to 16-10 and a 43-yard game-winner as time expired – in the 19-17 victory vs. Cin. (10/9)...The final boot marked his 19th-career game-winning FG (including playoffs) and was an NFL-record seventh with no time remaining

2021: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 17/0)

- En route to earning his fifth career Pro Bowl honor (and third straight), connected on 35-of-37 FGs and all 32 PAT tries, producing the NFL's highest marks in FG% (95.6%) and PAT% (100%)...Finished a perfect 6-of-6 on 50-plus-yard FGAs and 18-of-18 on second half FGs, including 10-of-10 in the fourth quarter/overtime...Connected on two game-winners – the 17th and 18th of his career – including an NFL-record 66-yarder at Det. (9/26)...Helped Baltimore's special teams unit rank No. 1 in *Football Outsiders'* DVOA rating
- Connected on all 4 of his FGAs vs. LAR (1/2/22), converting from 22, 46, 46 and 34 yards for his NFL-high 20th game of 4-plus FGM since entering the league in 2012...Reached thresholds of 130 points and 30 FGM on the season, producing his NFL-record sixth-straight season with 130-plus points and seventh season overall with 30-plus FGM
- Connected on all 3 FGAs, hitting from 42, 50 and 55 yards, and produced his first-career successful onside kick (recovered by S Chuck Clark), at Cle. (12/12)...It marked Baltimore's first successful onside kick since Week 5 of 2001 (at GB)...With 10 points scored in the game, surpassed Stephen Gostkowski (1,330) for the most points scored (1,331) through a player's first 10 seasons in NFL history...Also recorded his NFL-record eighth game with multiple 50-plus-yard FGM
- Connected on both of his FGs, hitting from 35 and 28 yards at Pit. (12/5)...Recorded his 25th FG of the season, becoming the first kicker in NFL history to reach that mark in each of the first 10 seasons of a career
- Connected on all 3 FGs for the second-consecutive game, hitting from 52, 25 and 49 yards in the 16-10 win vs. Cle. (11/28)...It marked his NFL-high 54th performance with at least 3 FGM since entering the league in 2012
- Connected on all 3 FGs in the 16-13 win at Chi. (11/21), helping Baltimore secure its first-ever win in Chicago...Notched his 96th performance with multiple FGM, setting a new NFL record by a kicker in the first 10 seasons of a career
- Connected on 2-of-2 FGAs, including the 36-yard game-winner to give Baltimore the 34-31 OT win vs. Min. (11/7)...It marked Tucker's 18th-career game-winning FG (including playoffs), and he extended his streak of consecutive FGM in the fourth quarter/OT to 53

- Connected on all 3 of his FGAs in the 23-7 win at Den. (10/3)...Reached 300 FGM in his 148th career game, surpassing K Stephen Gostkowski's previous record (167 games) to become the fastest kicker in NFL history to reach that milestone
- En route to AFC Special Teams Player of the Week honors, connected on 4-of-5 FGAs, including a 50-yarder and the game-winning and NFL-record 66-yarder, in the 19-17 victory at Det. (9/26)...Made kicks from 39, 50, 32 and 66 yards, after missing a 49-yard try (WR)...Notched his 17th-career game-winning FG (including playoffs) and improved to 16-of-16 on tries in the final minute of regulation during his career
- Connected on both FGAs from 40 and 47 yards and all 3 PATs at LV (9/13)...Has now made 26-of-27 FGAs (96.3%) in 11 Monday night contests...Extended his fourth-quarter, consecutive field goals made to 48 straight, marking the NFL's longest active streak

2020: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 16/0, 2/0)

- Connected on 26-of-29 (89.7) FGAs and 52-of-53 (98.1) PATs, en route to his fourth-overall and second-consecutive Pro Bowl nod...Finished with at least 130 points for his fifth-consecutive season, tying the NFL record of consecutive seasons with 130-plus points (Stephen Gostkowski, 2011-15 & David Akers, 2008-12)
- Drilled 2-of-3 FGAs, including a 51-yarder in the fourth quarter of the 20-13 Wild Card Playoff win at Ten. (1/10/21)...The 51-yard make was the second-longest playoff boot of his career (52 yards; 1/3/15 at Pit.)
- Connected on a game-winning 55-yard FG with :02 remaining to give Baltimore a 45-42 lead in the victory at Cle. (12/14)...Now owns 16-career game-winning FGs (15 regular season and 1 playoff), with 10 of those coming on the road
- Connected on 3-of-3 FGAs, including a season-long 55-yarder, and all 3 PATs in the 30-28 win at Phi. (10/18)...Has hit the second most 50-plus yard FGs (40) since entering the NFL in 2012
- Connected on each of his 4 FGAs and 3 PATs (15 total points) in the 33-16 win at Hou. (9/20)...Also appeared in his 130th-straight game, surpassing LB Jarret Johnson for the second-most consecutive-games played in Ravens history
- Connected on his only FGA (41 yards), also nailing all 5 PATs and producing 7 TBs on all his kickoffs, in the season-opening vs. Cle. (9/13)

2019: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 16/0, 1/0)

- Connected on 28-of-29 FGAs (96.6%) and a franchise-record 57 of 59 PATs, marking his fourth-consecutive year scoring exactly 141 points (a Ravens single-season scoring record)...Tucker is the NFL's only kicker to surpass the 140-point mark in each of the past four years (2016-19)
- Helped the Ravens produce the NFL's No. 1 scoring offense (33.2 ppg) and set a franchise record for points (531)
- Went 4-for-4 on FGAs, hitting from 45, 22, 42 and 47 yards in the 28-10 victory vs. Pit. (12/29)

- Clinched the Ravens' win with a 49-yard boot, marking his second game-winning FG of the season and his 15th-career game-winner, in the 20-17 victory vs. SF (12/1)
- Went 3-for-3 on FGAs, hitting from 25, 28 and 22 yards, and connected on all 3 PATs, in the 30-16 win at Sea. (10/20)
- Booted a 40-yard FG to become the fastest kicker in NFL history (118 games) to score 1,000 career points in the 23-17 victory vs. Cin. (10/13)...Tucker was 3-for-3 on FGAs, hitting from 40, 49 and 21 yards
- Kicked a 46-yard FG in OT to seal the Ravens' victory in the 26-23 win at Pit. (10/6)...The boot marked his 14th-career game-winning FG and his second such at Pittsburgh (52-yard OT kick in 2015)...In the win, Tucker was 4-for-4 on FGAs and 2-of-2 on PATs (14 total points)
- Connected on all 3 FGAs, hitting from 33, 28 and 51 yards in the 23-17 win vs. Ari. (9/15)

2018: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 16/0, 1/0)

- Earned first-team All-Pro and Pro Bowl first-alternate honors after connecting on 35-of-39 FGAs (misses were from 53 and 65 yards, and he had 2 kicks blocked)...Scored a franchise-record 141 points for the third-straight season, becoming the NFL's only kicker to surpass the 140 mark in each of the past three years
- Produced 10 points, connecting on 3 FGAs and 1 PAT, in the 22-10 win at LAC (12/22)...Became the first kicker in NFL history to produce six seasons with 30-plus FGM...Earned AFC Special Teams Player of the Week honors (his ninth-career award) for the performance
- Made all 4 FG attempts (41, 21, 45, 47 yards) and was 2-for-2 on PATs in the 26-16 win at Atl. (12/2)...Marked the 14th time in his career that Tucker made at least 4 FGs in a game
- Named AFC Special Teams Player of the Month for November after connecting on 8 of 8 FGAs, a perfect 6-for-6 on PATs, his sixth-career POM award
- Connected on both FGAs (47 and 28 yards) and was a perfect 3-for-3 on PATs in the 34-17 win vs. Oak. (11/25)...With his 10 points on the day, Tucker became the fastest pure kicker in league history to reach 900 career points, doing so in his 107th game...The only overall player to reach the milestone faster was WR/K Gino Cappelletti (106)
- Nailed all 3 FGAs, which included a season-long 56-yarder, in the 24-21 win vs. Cin. (11/18)...His 24-yard FG in the fourth quarter marked the 13th game-winning FG (including playoffs) of his career
- Named AFC Special Teams Player of the Month for September after connecting on 9 of 10 FGAs, a perfect 12-for-12 on PATs, and 3-for-3 on 50-yard-plus FGM
- Connected on two 52-yard FGs, setting an NFL-record with six-career games with multiple 50-plus-yard FGs in the 27-14 win vs. Den. (9/23)...Earned his eighth-career AFC Special Teams Player of the Week for his performance

2017: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 16/0)

- Earned *Associated Press* second-team All-Pro honors after connecting on 34 of 37 FGAs and tying his franchise record of 141 total points...Made his last 19 kicks, and his lone misses on the season were from 46 (blocked), 58 and 62 yards
- Connected on 3 FGAs, scoring his 800th-career point and becoming the fastest pure kicker in league history to reach the 800 milestone in the 23-16 victory vs. Ind. (12/23)
- Made all 3 of his FG attempts (38, 46, 51) and went a perfect 5-of-5 on PATs, helping the Ravens produce a season high in points in the 44-20 win vs. Det. (12/3)
- Named AFC Special Teams Player of the Month for November after converting on 8-of-8 FGAs and 6-of-6 on PATs in the month
- Scored 11 points, connecting on both PATs and all 3 FGAs (53, 31, 49) in a 23-16 win vs. Hou. (11/27)
- Scored his 700th-career point, connecting on 3 of 3 FGAs and 3 PATs in the 30-17 victory at Oak. (10/8)

2016: (BALTIMORE RAVENS – 16/0)

- Earned his second Pro Bowl invitation and was a unanimous first-team All-Pro selection after producing perhaps the greatest season ever by an NFL kicker...Scored a single-season franchise-record 141 points, connecting on 38 of 39 FGs (lone miss was a block) and 27 of 27 PATs
- Tucker's 38 FGs ranked first in the NFL, while he was 10-for-10 from 50-plus yards, tying (Blair Walsh, 2012) for the most such kicks in NFL single-season history...An NFL single-season record 24 of Tucker's 38 FGs made came from 40 yards or beyond (he was 24-of-24 on such boots)
