— KEY TRANSACTIONS —

- Signed with the Ravens as an undrafted rookie free agent on 5/4/23

— COLLEGE —

- Saw action in 45 games (seven starts) at William & Mary (2017-20) before playing at Monmouth (2021-22)... Totaled 355 carries for 1,403 rushing yards (4.0 avg.) and 23 rushing TDs as well as 27 receptions for 203 yards (7.5 avg.) and 2 receiving TDs over his six-year collegiate career... Also posted 425 yards on 21 KORs (20.2 avg.)
- Ranks 10th in Monmouth program history with 18 career rushing TDs
- As a graduate student in 2022, played in all 11 games at RB and on special teams, posting 72 carries for 304 yards (4.2 avg.) and 16 TDs, 2 receptions for 28 yards (14.0 avg.) and 1 TD, 3 KORs for 14 yards and 5 tackles on special teams... Posted at least 1 rushing TD in 10 games (including five games with 2+ TDs)... Awarded first-team All-CAA, *Phil Steele/DraftScout* FCS Postseason fourth-team All-American, Offensive Ray Michelli Coaches Award, NFF Hampshire Honor Society and was selected to play in the NFLPA Collegiate Bowl
- Appeared in all 11 games (one start) in his first season with Monmouth (2021), finishing with 91 carries for 370 yards (4.1 avg.) and 2 TDs as well as 7 receptions for 51 yards (7.3 avg.) and 1 TD... Scored 3 total TDs (2 rushing and 1 receiving) vs. North Alabama
- In his final season with William & Mary, rushed for 28 yards on 9 carries (3.1 avg.) and 24 yards on 3 receptions (8.0 avg.) vs. Richmond, the only game he appeared in during the condensed spring 2021 season (which was postponed from fall 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic)
- Saw action in 12 games (six starts) as a sophomore at William & Mary (2019) as both RB and KOR... Led the team with 584 rushing yards and 5 TDs on 183 carries (4.2 avg.)... Scored the game-winning 2-point conversion in the OT victory at Elon
- Appeared in all 10 games as a reserve RB and KOR... Tallied 117 rushing yards on 45 carries (2.6 avg.) and totaled 108 return yards on 3 KORs... Posted a career-long 57-yard return vs. Albany... Ranked sixth in the conference in yards per return (22.9)
- Redshirted as a scout team RB his freshman season in 2017
- Earned CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll distinction in three seasons (2017, 19-20)
- Majored in business with a minor in kinesiology

— HIGH SCHOOL/PERSONAL —

- Attended Georgetown Prep (Bethesda, MD) where he played RB and finished with 2,078 rushing yards and 33 TDs on 385 carries (5.4 avg.) over three seasons... Earned first-team All-IAC and second-team All-State accolades after totaling 1,247 rushing yards and 19 TDs as a junior
- Was a member of Government club, College Sports club and Black Students Association (BSA)
- Grandfather, Brig Owens, was an All-American QB at the University of Cincinnati and played safety in the NFL for Washington (1966-77)
- Enjoys community service, working out and watching movies
