- Helped RB Ralph Webb become the team's all-time leading rusher and QB Kyle Shurmur produce one of the best seasons ever by a Commodores' QB
- Earned SEC Offensive Lineman of the Week honors for his performance vs. Ole Miss when he had three key blocks that resulted in TDs
- Started all 12 games at LT as a junior in 2015 after converting from RT due to a preseason injury...Played more than 870 offensive snaps, second most on the offensive line, and was credited with 33 pancake and 13 domination blocks

- Attended Clay (Green Cove Springs, FL) HS, where he was a three-year starter, earning first-team All-State honors as a senior in 2012
- Was named to *The Florida Times-Union's* prestigious Super 24 Team as a senior
